

Time to turn your back on spine trouble

IF THERE'S one repercussion that the vagaries of the 21st century have had on people, it is the emergence of lifestyle disorders. And one lifestyle disorder that's really getting on people's back is spinal problems. Two UK-based doctors, however, have arrived in the city to look into the problem.

It was some years ago that Dr Jeffery R. McConnell of OAA Orthopaedic Specialists, Cardiff, came across Dr Ujjwal Debnath, a spine specialist who's a Kolkatan by birth and spirit. Debnath told McConnell of his wish to return to Bengal and put his expertise to use there. This, Debnath said, he wanted to do since the only Indian institutes for spinal surgeries are concentrated in the north, south and worked at a refugee camp at the US Naval base in Guantanamo Bay, agreed to accompany his friend to Kolkata.


Once in the city, the two doctors decided to set up base at Ramakrishna Mission Seva Pratisthan (RKMSP), since this is where Debnath had started his career. RKMSP director Swami Sarvalokananda expressed great happiness at the doctors' proposal, and asked them to hold a clinic in the mission's hospital in November. Despite this hospital

Julie a 10 years old girl's success story

Julie was seen in OSS camp in Mar 2009 with quadriplegia due to tuberculous destruction of the upper cervical vertebrae and spinal cord compression.



She underwent the difficult Surgery for 6 hours under 'OSS'. She was later rehabilitated by HOPE FOUNDATION, Kolkata.



She is getting formal education and is performing on stage (Indian dances) with the fellow Girls from HOPE FOUNDATION.



FURTHER SUCCESS IN YOUNG CHILDREN



Ankit- now a five year old boy who was first seen when he was a nine month baby. His family could not afford any expensive treatment for his spinal problem. We followed him every six months for his vertebral deformity which he was born with. His spinal curvature progressed with high right shoulder. He underwent correction of his curvature with rods and hooks. He made a good recovery and going to school.

Ankita - presented to us with right leg weakness and loss of weight. Investigation suggested spinal tuberculosis (TB). She underwent operation for dorsolumbar TB through back as well as abdomen. At the end of one year she is completely cured of her illness.



Bacchu - a 11 year old boy continued to progress with his lumbar (lower back) curvature due to a malformed vertebrae from birth. He had been treated with brace by local doctors. He could not afford surgical correction. He underwent a three hour surgery to remove the deformed vertebra and instrumented fusion to correct the spine alignment to normal for his age. He and his parents were grateful to us.



The function will be followed by Cultural Programme.




